It is particularly recommended for the treatment of inaccessible areas such as roof voids and service ducts where spraying is impractical and around electrical installations where spraying is undersirable. Ficam D can be used in and around buildings including houses, blocks of flats, hospitals, warehouses, factories, museums, military establishments, vehicles, ships and aircraft. It can be used in continuously occupied areas as a band/spot or crack and crevice treatment only.
