USE RESTRICTIONS

Bird Free is a gel which may be used to deter pigeons (Columba livia) from roosting or nesting in, on or around buildings and other structures. *Bird Free* is supplied in pre-packed covered plastic dishes. These should be affixed to dry surfaces with commercially available silicone adhesive (eg, Soudal Silirub), or other suitable adhesive. (See PREPAR-ING SURFACES FOR TREATMENT on rear panel). Once affixed, the covers should be removed from the dishes.
